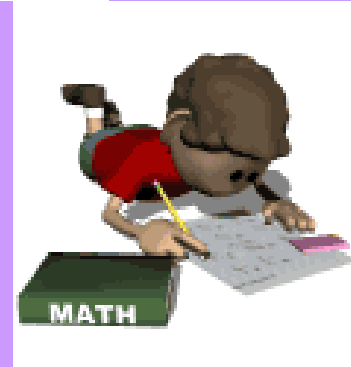

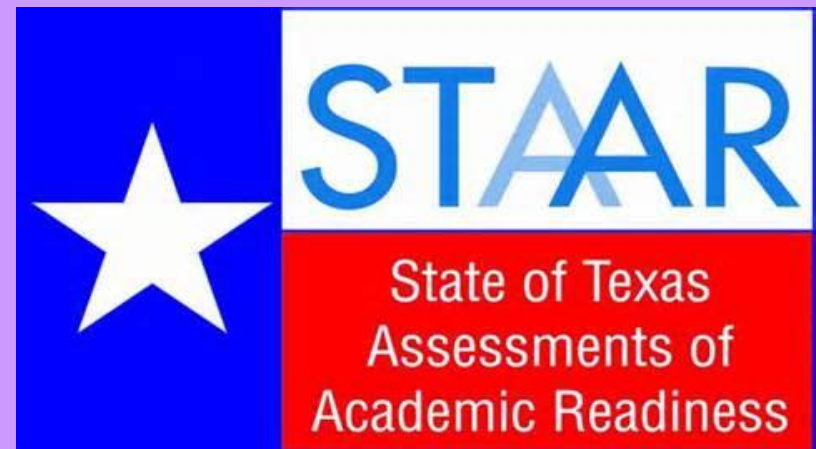
Student Success Initiative (SSI)
